A Living Sacrifice



- Promised beforehand (1:1)
- Gospel is the power of God for salvation (1:15-16)
- His kindness leads us to repentance (2:4)
- He shows no partiality (2:11)
- He is True (3:4)
- None is righteous (3:10)
- Shows us our sin through the knowledge of the law (3:20)
- Righteousness of God through faith in Christ (3:22)
- All have sinned and fall short of God's glory (3:23)
- Justified by His grace as a gift! Through the redemption in Christ (3:24)

- God put Christ forward to receive His wrath, (propitiation - 3:25)
- We have peace with God through our faith in Christ (5:1)
- While we were still sinners, while we were still weak, at the right time, Christ died for us (5:6, 8)
- Sin's wages = death. Free gift of God = eternal life (6:23)
- No condemnation for those who are in Christ (8:1)
- All things work together for good for those who are called (8:28)
- Gave up His Son for us, graciously gives us all things (8:32)
- Nothing can separate us from the love of God (8:37-39)

- Our sacrificial living must be motivated and powered by faith (9:32)
- Faith comes from hearing the word of Christ (10:17)
- Our suffering produces endurance (5:1-5)
- God's heirs, fellow heir of Christ, if we suffer with him (8:17)
- Spirit helps us in our weakness, for we do not know what to pray for (8:26-27)
